SUBJECT: June Library report

June kicked off with a reimagined Summer Reading program. This summer, we used an online platform through Bookpoints with a paper option. Children, teens, and adults earn points, raffle tickets, and discover secret codes by reading, listening, and learning.

Children participated in a weekly science, technology, engineering, art, or math (STEAM) challenge with materials commonly found at home or from a supply kit from the Library. In June, they built troll bridges, boats that float and fairy bells and wind chimes. Stayton Storytime Fairies visited the Storytime Stage by the doors of the south end of the Library. They left clues to the story they were sharing for the week as well as other songs, rhymes, and early literacy tips. The Stayton Library Puppet Theater presented our first two puppet show videos "The Little Red Hen" and "Jack and the Beanstalk". The puppet shows have been very popular. Jennifer, Emily & Kim hosted Virtual Storytime on Zoom and created a webpage so families who missed it can access the rhymes, songs, and books they used. Our first Storywalk® went up in the Community Center Park behind the Library featuring the book *Ninja Red Riding Hood* by Corey Rosen Schwartz.

Stephanie put together a six-week Crafts to Go series for teens and adults. Tutorial videos and paper instructions were provided. Supply kits were available for pick up. The June Craft to Go program was DIY paper bunting.

Library curbside pickup appointment slots were doubled in June and Saturday hours were added. Patrons can place holds and make appointments to pick up their items either online or over the phone. A quarantine system is being used to safely provide the pickup service and process returning items. Reader's advisory service was expanded over the phone and online to help patrons who miss browsing the shelves or need help finding their next read.
