SUBJECT: March Library report

March began with stories, games, crafts and cake as we celebrated Dr. Seuss' Birthday. Almost a hundred people joined in the festivities. New sessions of Motion Monday and Storytime started. Teens and adults made felt flower wreaths at our DIY Craftshop, and Rachel started a monthly Dungeons and Dragons program for teens. Oregon author John Larison visited. His book, *Whiskey When We're Dry* is a reboot of the western format and a 2019 Oregon Book Award Finalist.

Spring Break programming kicked off with Cocoa with the Cops. Sergeant Meeks helped Library staff serve cocoa. Children and their families toured a police car with Officer Mumey, visited with Lieutenant Button and played with K-9 Officer Dallas and his tennis ball. At our Maker Challenge kids built their own UWOs (unidentified wobbling objects). Teens programs included a game of life-size Clue and a screening of *Spider-man: Into the Spider-verse*.
