SUBJECT: March Library report

For the first five days of March, in honor of the National Education Association's Read Across America, the nation's largest reading celebration, the Library hosted a series of virtual readalouds featuring a cast of storybook characters. The identities of the readers were kept secret. Each day a new reader shared a story of their choice and provided a mystery reader interview. Case files of clues to the readers' secret identities were compiled online and at the Library. After two weeks of clue gathering, the mystery reader's secret identities of The Little Red Hen, Count Dracula, Sherlock Holmes, Rapunzel and Long John Silver were revealed. Thank you to our amazing puppeteers: Jennifer, Stephanie, Nicole, Rachel, and Ryan.

Adults and teens made woven coasters with their March take and make kits, and children ages 7-11 explored ways to undercover fingerprints on surfaces. Children ages 3-6 received detective kits with a magnifying glass, fingerprint cards, evidence bags and more to imagine a detective's job and encourage dramatic play.

Magna-tiles, Snap Circuits, Bird Watching Kits, a Botley Coding Robot, and more Library of Things items have begun checking out. Stephanie is working on the extensive cataloging process to get the rest of the items ready for checkout in the coming weeks. Thank you to the Stayton Library Foundation and our many generous donors for making our Library of Things collection possible.

The Library hosted The Salem Reads Art Exhibit throughout March. The art on display was inspired by the Salem Reads 2022 book, *A Tale for the Time Being* by Ruth Ozeki. Children hunted for gold coins and a four-leaf clover to solve a riddle and earn a prize in the Library during the week of St. Patrick's day. Beginning March 19, 2022, Library hours were extended by opening from 10am to 2pm on Saturdays.
