SUBJECT: March Library report

In March, over 280 people explored our Simply Spring Crafts during Spring Break. Evie facilitated a teen meetup and volunteer opportunity, and fourteen of our teen volunteers came and collaborated on a selection of projects. Forty-seven people of all ages joined Stephanie, Nicole, and Janna to decoupage birdhouses.

Adults met for Book Club with Stephanie to discuss *Faye Faraway* by Helen Fisher, and AARP Tax Aides helped families complete their tax returns. People of all ages used our collection of odds and ends to create unique pieces of art at our Scavenger Collage program. Evie and Janna opened our STEAM Lab for an hour after school every afternoon for a week, and children unleashed their inner builders with our LEGOs.

The Library hosted the Oregon Community Foundation's Northern Willamette Valley Leadership Council. Janna and Deana Freres presented and gave a tour. It was an excellent opportunity to highlight the exciting things happening at the Library. Jennifer was a special guest reader in a 2nd-grade classroom at Stayton Elementary School. Janna ran the CCRLS Polk, Yamhill and Marion County (PYM) Library Directors meeting and attended the CCRLS Advisory Council meeting as the PYM chair.
