SUBJECT: May Library report

In May, bored dinosaurs snuck into curbside pickup bags with children's books in them, looking for adventures. Children and families shared pictures and stories of their dinosaurs' prehistoric adventures with Jennifer and Emily at Zoom Storytime and on the Library's Facebook page.

The Library was accepted into this year's Libros for Oregon cohort. The program will provide the opportunity for the Library to purchase \$1,000 worth of Spanish language books through the international book fair of Guadalajara. It is a great opportunity for the development of the Spanish language collection. Stephanie received a \$1,000 grant from The State Library of Oregon for books for teens focusing on mental and physical health and funding for supplies for teen take & make kits for September through December. Jennifer received a national grant for \$2,000 from Save the Children for giveaway books for middle-grade children.

We partnered with Tammy Baxter from Stayton Middle School and Stayton Library Foundation to give out over 250 books to students at Stayton Intermediate School and Stayton Middle School. We gave out 166 take & make kits at our drive-thru pick up event. Children learned about simple machines by building gears out of pool noodles and explored steampunk-inspired art with a geared keychain project. Teens made origami cranes, and adults created yarn birds. The instructions for each project were posted on the Library website so people who were unable to get kits could still complete the projects with their own supplies.

The local option levy for the Library passed with overwhelming support. We are so grateful to our community! Thank you to all of the volunteers who worked on the levy and especially to Susan Brandt, who led the PAC.

Curbside pickup service continued. Holds and appointments can be made online or over the phone. Library staff have developed several options to facilitate browsing and work individually

with people to offer a more personalized experience. We have created options for patrons to receive customized reading suggestions, surprise bags, and even read titles to patrons over the phone.
