SUBJECT: May Library report

In May, Jennifer wrapped up our current Storytime session. Storytime will return during Summer Reading and will happen throughout the community in the parks starting with Northslope Park on June 28. Children built simple ball launching machines with their take & make kits. Teens created beaded safety pin bracelets, and adults made quilled flower cards.

Evie planned and coordinated an 8<sup>th</sup>-grade work party from Regis St. Mary Catholic School that included facing shelves, moving boxes of donations, weeding outside, and creating trees and a banner to help decorate the Library for the Summer Reading Program. In addition, we hosted a 9<sup>th</sup>-grade Regis St. Mary class field trip, and Jennifer provided storytimes at Stayton Elementary's Kindergarten Roundup.

Thanks to two grants, we have been able to add \$4,000 worth of Spanish language materials to our collection. We received a \$15,000 ARPA grant facilitated through the State Library of Oregon to increase our Spanish-language collection and translate Library forms and materials into Spanish. We are also part of this year's Libros for Oregon cohort, which is providing additional Spanish-language books purchased from the international book fair in Guadalajara. This is, in part, a result of a greater effort to update our existing aging Spanish collection and ensure that we are serving the entire community of Stayton with current and relevant materials.
