SUBJECT: September Library report

September began with new sessions of Motion Monday, Family Storytime and BabyTime. Emily, our Early Outreach Coordinator, started a new monthly Pajama Storytime. Children used straw painting to create a blow art masterpiece. More than 50 children and their parents built and experimented with Bristlebots at our Maker Lab. Teens created birch tree paintings with a resist technique and adults made soy candles in teacups at our DIY Craftshop. We also hosted "South Africa through the Eyes of Michael Moloi," the story of South African mineworkers during the time of apartheid told through dance, storytelling, singing and poetry.

Library Volunteer Coordinator, Evie Thomas, hosted a Volunteer Appreciation BBQ and shelf reading party. We celebrated volunteering milestones: Marion Bell – 20 years of volunteering at the Library, Susan Brandt, Marla Brummer, and Barbara Willetts - 15 years.
