**SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- March 2020**

**KEY ACTIVITIES**

**STATUS**

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 44.69 million gallons were treated during March. The highest Daily flow was 2.10 million gallons on the 31st and the lowest flow was 1.08 million gallons on the 8th. The average flow was 1.44 million gallons. Total rainfall for March was 4.61 inches. 28.98 dry tons of bio solids were produced. 46 yards and Five 5 Gallon buckets of bio solids were given to citizens in March.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 2,767,000 gallons on March 20<sup>th</sup>.
- **Water System** Replaced 4 water meters and 3 meter boxes. Cleaned water filter bed #1.
- **Streets** Swept 104 curb miles and 25 cubic yards of material was collected. 0 lbs. of cold mix and 0 yards of gravel were applied to street potholes and street cutouts. Replaced one no parking sign and one speed sign.
- **Parks** None for March 2020
