Police Officer - Lateral

The City of Stayton is seeking qualified applicants for a Lateral Police Officer position. The successful candidate will protect life and property, control and arrest offenders of the law, handle disturbances of the peace, and prevent crime by enforcing Federal, State, and Local Laws. Carry out duties in conformance with Federal, State, County and City laws and Codes.

To be considered a qualified lateral applicant, you must currently be certified as an Oregon Police Officer, successfully completed a minimum twelve (12) month probationary period and have a minimum of two (2) years full-time on the job experience. Additionally, candidates must pass a background and psychological evaluation. Out-of-state applicants must be eligible to become Oregon certified by attending the 80-hour Police Career Officer's Development Course offered by the Department of Police Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) and have successfully completed the NTN written test offered at www.nationaltestingnetwork.com. Out-of-state candidates must take and pass the NTN examination before advancing in the process.

Salary starts at \$50,702 to \$67,946.40 annually depending on education, experience, and training plus benefits and Oregon PERS/OPSRP.
