ORDINANCE NO. 294

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE USE AND OBSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON as follows:

Section 1. OBSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to place, park, leave, or maintain any commodity, building material merchandise, or other obstruction of any sidewalk that extends over thirty six inches beyond the private boundary line of a business building. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the display of such goods and materials upon private property nor shall this section be construed to apply to persons receiving or discharging goods, wares, or merchandise across a sidewalk, provided due diligence is used in removing the same.

Section 2. OBSTRUCTION OF ALLEYS. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to place, park, leave, or maintain any commodity, building material, merchandise, or other obstruction of any alley that extends over thirty inches beyond the private boundary line of a business building. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the display of such goods and materials upon private property nor shall this section be construed to apply to persons receiving or discharging goods, wares, or merchandise across an alley, provided due diligence is used in removing the same.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall maintain any commodity, building material, merchandise or other obstruction of any sidewalk or alley shall, upon request of the City Recorder, give written proof of carrying liability insurance to cover any such hazard.

Section 4. PERMIT FOR OBSTRUCTION. The City Recorder, upon request, may issue a written permit to allow sidewalks to be enroached upon beyond thirty/inches, where and alleys to be enroached upon beyond thirty inches, where necessary for the alteration or construction of buildings.

Section 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdeameanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined any sum not exceeding \$50.00.

Section 6. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 7. It is the judgment of this council that an emergency exists and that it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Stayton, that this ordinance shall take effect and be in operation immediately upon its passage and approval by the mayor.
