

ORDINANCE No. 808

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.36 PLANNING COMMISSION SECTIONS 2.36.920(1) & (2) MEMBERSHIP, TERMS, FILLING OF VACANCIES, ORGANIZATION"; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton Municipal Code allows for a variety of boards, commissions, and committees to exist for the purpose of advising and recommending to the Stayton City Council;

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council deems it appropriate to establish the number of member of the Planning Commission to promote efficiency in decision making and for the purpose of establishing terms of the Planning Commission members whose terms expire in December 2000;

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that an emergency be declared as to the enactment of this Ordinance so that it is in full force and effective immediately from and after its adoption by the Stayton City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Stayton Municipal Code Section 2.36.920(1) & (2) are hereby amended to read:

1. The commission shall consist of nine (9) adult members and one non-voting high school student of junior level academic standing, enrolled at either Stayton Union High School or Regis High School. Not more than two (2) members of the City Council, if appointed by the mayor, shall serve as ex-officio, non-voting representative. Members are appointed in accordance with the Rules of the Stayton City Council.
2. Terms of office for planning commission members:
 - a. The high school student shall hold office for one (1) year commencing at the commission's January meeting.
 - b. The nine adult Commission members shall hold office for three (3) years on staggered terms.
 - c. Staggered terms shall be accomplished, on a one time basis, by reducing the term of one Planning Commission member's position by one year at the time of the January 2001 appointments.

SECTION 2. Upon adoption by the Stayton City Council and the Mayor's signing, this Ordinance shall become immediately effective .
