ORDINANCE NO. 871

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE ("SMC") TITLE 8, "HEALTH AND SAFETY," SECTION 8.04.055, REGARDING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council, in April 1996, adopted Ordinance No. 760, amending SMC section 8.04.055, prohibiting the consumption of any alcoholic beverages on public property;

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council has determined that certain public facilities are not being fully utilized because of the alcoholic beverage ban thereon; and,

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council has determined that, when certain criteria are met, public facility users may be granted a permit from the City to allow the consumption of alcoholic beverages at the Stayton Community Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The Stayton Municipal Code section 8.04.055 is hereby amended and restated to read as follows:

8.04.055 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

No person shall drink or consume alcoholic beverages in or upon any public street, alley, public grounds, parks or City-owned facilities and properties, except the Stayton Community Center when a permit for that purpose, at that location only, has been properly obtained from the City.

- 1. Upon application to the City, the City Administrator, or designee, pursuant to subsection (2) below, may grant a revocable facility use permit to responsible persons or organizations for an event or activity at which alcoholic beverages may be served and consumed at the Stayton Community Center.
- 2. The Stayton City Council shall adopt rules governing facility use permits by Resolution.
