

ORDINANCE NO. 717

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 8., "HEALTH AND SAFETY," BY CREATING SECTION NUMBER 8.04.055, "PROHIBITING CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, there is no prohibition in this code against the consumption of alcoholic beverages on public property; and
WHEREAS, conditions are such that such a prohibition is necessary to preserve the health, safety, and interests of the public;
NOW, THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: The STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE is hereby amended by creating Section 8.04.055 to read:

8.04.055 PROHIBITING CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

No person shall drink or consume alcoholic beverages in or upon any public street, alley, public grounds, parks, city-owned facilities, or other public place unless a permit has been granted by the city.

1. Upon application to the city, the city administrator or his designee may grant a revokable facility use permit to responsible persons or organizations for an event or activity at which alcoholic beverages may be served.
2. The Stayton City Council may adopt rules governing facility use permits by separate resolution.

SECTION 2: It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance amending the Stayton Municipal Code sections related to alcoholic consumption on public property is necessary to serve the public health, safety, welfare, convenience, and environmental amenities of the City of Stayton and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect when executed by the mayor.
