

ORDINANCE No. 780

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 2, "ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL"; CHAPTER 2.08 "CITY ADMINISTRATOR"; SECTION 110 "OFFICE CREATED" AND SECTION 150 "SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY" AND ORDINANCE 658; SECTION 2.620 AND SECTION 2.633.

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Charter stipulates the Council may designate any appointive officer to supervise any other appointive officer except the Municipal Judge in the exercise of the judicial functions and;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 658 was adopted to create the office of City Administrator and stipulate the office's supervisory authority and;

WHEREAS, a conflict has been determined to exist between the City Charter and Ordinance No. 658 as reflected in the Code and;

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the City any conflicts in approved legislation be resolved;

NOW THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.08.110, "Office Created," is hereby amended to read:

There is created the office of City Administrator for the city, with the appointee of such office having general supervision, direction, and control over all nonelective officers and employees in the exercise of their duties and of work of all city departments, other than the office of municipal judge, which is specifically exempt from the control of the administrator.

SECTION 2: STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.08.150(1) "Supervisory Authority," is hereby amended to read:

1. The Administrator has, in exercising general charge, supervision and control over all nonelective city employees and their work with the exception of the municipal judge.
