## ORDINANCE NO. 626

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION FOR: A STREET IMPROVEMENT LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of providing funds for street improvements within the City of Stayton, and for no other purpose, the Stayton City Council hereby proposes a serial levy of \$120,000.00 per year, for three years, outside the tax base limitation imposed by Oregon Constitution Article XI, Section 11.

The proceeds of the authorized levy shall be set aside in a Street Improvement Serial Levy Fund separate and distinct from other funds of the City.

The total outlay for the purpose of this levy is \$360,000.00.

- SECTION 2. This Ordinance is submitted to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection at the election to be held between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., June 24, 1986.
- SECTION 3. For purpose of submitting this measure to the electorate, the following ballots are hereby approved and adopted:

Caption: Three Year Street Improvement Levy

Question: Shall the City of Stayton levy \$360,000.00 for street improvements beginning in fiscal year 1986-1987?

## Explanation:

The Stayton City Council proposes a Street Improvement Serial Levy of \$120,000.00 per year outside the tax base limitation imposed by Article XI, Section 11 of the State Constitution, for three consecutive years, beginning with the 1986-1987 fiscal year to provide funds for Street Improvements and for no other purpose, at an aggregate cost for the three year period of \$360,000.00.

- SECTION 4. The City Administrator is hereby instructed to take such action as is necessary to insure the presentation of this measure to the voters.
- SECTION 5. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions in the City of Stayton are of such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the City and the inhabitants thereof, and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
