ORDINANCE NO. 648

AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION FOR A LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION SERIAL LEVY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

For the purpose of providing funds for the construction of a new public library within the City of Stayton, and for no other purpose, the Stayton City Council hereby proposes a serial levy of \$50,000.00 per year for three (3) years outside the tax base limitation imposed by the Oregon Constitution, Article XI, Section 11, beginning in fiscal year 1989.1990. The aggregate total for the three year serial levy is \$150,000.00.

The proceeds of the authorized levy shall be set aside in a Library Construction Serial Levy Fund separate and distinct from other funds of the City.

SECTION 2

This Ordinance is submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection at the election to be held on November 8, 1988.

SECTION 3

For the purpose of submitting this measure to the electorate, the following ballots are hereby approved and adopted:

CAPTION

Three-Year Library Construction Levy

QUESTION

Shall the City of Stayton levy \$50,000 per year for three (3) years outside the tax base for construction of a new public library? (Beginning in 1989-1990)

STATEMENT

The City of Stayton proposes a Library Construction Serial Levy of \$50,000 per year outside the tax base.

The levy will be for three (3) consecutive years beginning in 1989. The levy will provide funds to construct a new Stayton Public Library and for no other purpose. The estimated cost of the library is \$432,000.00. This tax levy will pay \$150,000.00 of the cost. The remaining cost of library construction will come from grants, donations, and other funds.

SECTION 4

The City Administrator is hereby instructed to take such action as is necessary to insure the presentation of this measure to the qualified electors.

SECTION 5

In the event the City obtains additional funds for the construction of the new library or if bids are lower than the estimated cost of construction, the Council agrees to reduce or eliminate the serial tax levy in fiscal year 1990-1991 and/or fiscal year 1991-1992.

SECTION 6

It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions in the City of Stayton are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City and the inhabitants thereof, and an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
