ORDINANCE NO. 329

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF STAYTON, MARION COUNTY, OREGON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 306, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON:

<u>Section 1.</u> The following named streets in the City of Stayton, which are hereinafter listed, hereby are changed from the present existing names, to the new names hereinafter set opposite the presently existing names as follows, to-wit:

Old Name	New Name
Barbara Avenue	Fern Avenue
Mehama Road	Santiam Street

Section 2. Inasmuch as the adoption of this ordinance will have an effect upon the delivery of mail within the said City and in order that as much confusion as is possible might be avoided, it is hereby considered that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary for the health, peace, safety and welfare of the City of Stayton, Oregon, and of its inhabitants and an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
