ordinance no. 350

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE IN THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The rates to be charged all persons, firms, or corporations shall be reasonable and uniform, taking into consideration the service rendered, and shall not be in excess of the following schedule:

Residential Rates (one family unit)

1 can per week, per month 2 cans per week, per month	\$1.50 \$2.00
Commercial Rates:	
One trip per week 1 can \$1.50 2 cans \$1.75 4 cans \$3.25 5 cans \$4.00	3 cans \$2.50
Two trips per week

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary immediately for the public health, peace and safety of the City of Stayton, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
