ORDINANCE NO. 356

An Ordinance levying a special property tax of \$2,000.00 per year outside the constitutional six percent limitation for a period of not to exceed three years beginning with the fiscal year 1966.67 for the purpose of providing funds in addition to those regularly budgeted, for salaries of members of the City Police Department; submitting such ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection at a special city election to be held May 24, 1966; and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. For the purpose of providing funds in addition to those regularly budgeted, for salaries of members of the City Police Department, the Council each year for a period of not to exceed three consecutive years, beginning with the fiscal year 1966-67, shall levy a special property tax of \$2,000.00 per year outside the limitation imposed by Article XI, Section 11, of the Constitution of the State of Oregon. The proceeds of said tax levies shall be set aside by the City Recorder in a "Police Department Salary Fund" separate and distinct from other city funds, to be used for no other purpose than herein authorized.

Section 2. The Council estimates that the total outlay for the purposes authorized by this ordinance will be the sum of \$6,000.

Section 3. This ordinance is submitted to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection at a special city election hereby called to be held between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M., Pacific Daylight Time,

on May 24, 1966.

Section 4. The following ballot title prepared by the City Attorney, under which this Ordinance shall be submitted to the voters of the city, is hereby approved and adopted:

ORDINANCE REFERRED TO THE VOTERS BY THE CITY COUNCIL Shall Ordinance No.35% of the City of Stayton, Oregon, be adopted to authorize a tax levy by the City Council of \$2,000 per year outside the limitation imposed by Article XI, Section 11, of the State Constitution for three consecutive years beginning with the fiscal year 1966-67 to provide funds in addition to those regularly budgeted or hereafter budgeted for fiscal years subsequent to the fiscal year 1966-67, for the payment of salaries of members of the City Police Department, at an estimated aggregate cost from said levies for such three years, of \$6,000.

- 51 Yes, I vote for the Ordinance.

Section 5. The polling places and election boards for the state-wide primary election held on May 24, 1966, shall be the polling places and election boards respectively for the said city election. The Recorder is hereby instructed to post and publish notices of the said election in the manner provided by Ordinance No. 242 of said city and to furnish to the election board for said election the necessary records, ballot boxes, tally sheets, and election supplies.

Section 6. Said election shall be conducted in accordance with the election laws of the State of Oregon and with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Stayton. The ballots cast at said

election shall be counted, tabulated, and returned to the Recorder of said city. Upon approval by the voters of the said ordinance the Mayor, in conformity with Ordinance No. 242 of said city, shall issue his proclamation of the result of said election.

Section 7. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions in the City of Stayton are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City and the inhabitants there-of, and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
