ORDINANCE No. 126

A BILL

For an ordinance to provide for the revising, codifying and printing of the ordinances of the town of Stayton, Oregon, and for the codifying and printing of the charter of said town, and declaring an emergency to exist, and that this ordinance shall become immediately operative upon its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That S. H. Heltzel, attorney-at-law of Stayton, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to revise, codify and print in duplicate, under the direction and supervision of the Council, all of the ordinances of the town of Stayton from Ordinance No. 1, to and including Ordinance No. 125, and also to codify and print the Charter of said town in duplicate.

Section 2. Said charter and ordinances shall be printed upon a good grade of ledger paper 8 1/2 by 14 inches in dimension which has been previously punched suitable for loose leaf binders, and shall be placed in substantial loose leaf covers.

Section 3. The Recorder of the Town of Stayton shall be the custodian of said charter and ordinances after the same have been printed and accepted by the Council. One volume shall be kept for the use of the public and the officers of said town, and the other one shall be kept in a fireproof vault under the direction of the recorder.

Section 4. The Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to purchase suitable loose leaf books and paper for said charter and ordinances the same to be paid for out of the general fund of said town.

Section 5. In order to carry out the objects and purposes of this ordinance more fully, said S. H. Heltzel is hereby appointed attorney for said town of Stayton for the term ending Jan. 1st, 1917.

Section 6. Inasmuch as want of information concerning the existing ordinances tends to great and dangerous uncertainty in the administration and execution thereof, the health, peace and safety of the town of Stayton require the immediate taking effect of this ordinance; wherefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon ita passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
