

ORDINANCE NO. 155

A Bill of an Ordinance providing for the enforcement of the rules and regulations of the ex officio board of health of the town of Stayton; providing a penalty for the violation thereof, and declaring an emergency to exist.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ~~DEDAIN~~ **DEDAIN** AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That any person or persons violating any of the rules and regulations of the ex officio board of health of the town of Stayton, adopted for the purpose of checking the spread of influenza within the town shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Town Recorder shall be fined in a sum not less that \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the town jail not less that five nor more than **fifty** days.

Section 2. That it is the judgment of the Council that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the town, and that it shall become immediately operative upon its passage by the Council and approval of the mayor.
