## ORDINANCE NO. 58.

A Bill for an Ordinance to vacate the alley extending through Block No. three (3) in Thomas' Addition to the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon.

WHEREAS, it appearing to the Council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, from the verified petition of A. D. Gardner, that he is the sole owner of all of Block No. Three (3) in Thomas' Addition to the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, and it further appearing to the Council from the proofs now on file that due and legal notice of the pendency of said petition has been given for more than thirty days previous to the 7th day of November, 1901, the regular November setting of the Council of said Town and no opposition having been made or filed to said petition; and it further appearing to the Council that the interests of the public will not be prejudiced by the granting of said petition, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the alley running North and South being 16 feet wide and extending through Block No. Three (3) in Thomas' Addition to the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, as shown and designated upon the recorded plat thereof, now on file and of record in the Recorder's Office of said Marion County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated the whole way through same block as herein described, provided the same petitioner shall pay all the costs and expenses of said petition and this proceeding.
