ORDINANCE NO. 504

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 475 OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, RELATING TO VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC:

The City of Stayton ordains as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of Section 14 of Ordinance Number 475 of the City of Stayton entitled "An Ordinance Controlling Vehicular and Pedestrian Traffic; Providing Penalties; and Repealing Ordinances." enacted the 20th day of December, 1976, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 14. Applicability of the Oregon Vehicle Code to Traffic Offenses Upon Other Property Open to Public Travel.

(1) The provisions of the Oregon Vehicle Code shall apply upon any other property open to public travel. Any conduct or status that would constitute a traffic offense, infraction, or crime under the Oregon Vehicle Code, if it occurred on a public street will, if it occurs on other property open to public travel, constitute a municipal traffic infraction under the provisions of this section.

Section 2. Section 15, 16, 17 and 18 of Ordinance Number 475 of the City of Stayton are hereby repealed.
