

ORDINANCE NO. 518

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON CODE SECTION NUMBER 6.613, SUB-SECTION 5, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section VI of the Stayton Code is amended as follows:

6.613 Public Safety-Noxious Vegetation

Subsection 5. Between April 1 and May 15 of each year, the City Administrator shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, a copy of Subsection 1, 2, and 3 of Section 6.613 as a notice to all property owners and persons in charge of property of their duty to keep their property free from noxious vegetation. The notice shall state that failure to comply with the removal of noxious vegetation will result in a warning violation being issued. A ten day "corrective period" will be provided for and should the violation exist thereafter, a citation shall be issued to the owner or person in charge.

Section 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; and, owing to the urgent necessity of maintaining the public peace, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of passage.
