

RESOLUTION NO. 804

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING SANITARY SEWER USER CHARGES: NON-INDUSTRIAL FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF STAYTON.

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council for the City of Stayton has adopted Ordinance No. 781, "Repealing SMC Title 13.24.1190";

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 781 (SMC Title 13.24.1190) requires rates to be established for sanitary sewer service;

WHEREAS, the adopted Sewer Master Plan recommends a series of rate increases over the next 5 years, and for fiscal year 2007-08 beginning July 1, 2007, it recommends a 7.5 percent rate increase; and,

WHEREAS, such rates are to be set in resolution form.

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council deems it appropriate and timely that water rates more accurately reflect and support the fiscal needs of the City's sanitary sewer system and service in accordance with the Sewer Master Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Stayton City Council hereby adopts sanitary sewer rates as follows:

SECTION 1. SANITARY SEWER RATES

Users of the sewer system are classified based on estimated loadings to the sewer system and rates are hereby established for each classification:

<u>Class</u>	<u>Loading</u>	<u>\$/Month</u>
A	Up to 4,000 gal/month	\$27.85
B	Up to 6,000 gal/month	37.25
C	Up to 10,000 gal/month	69.57
D	Over 10,000 gal/month (cost per thousand)	6.96
E	Commercial Recreational Vehicle	27.85
	Waste Disposal per gallon	0.30

Water consumption for the months of October through March shall be used to classify users except that the following classes are hereby established:

Single Family Units and Manufactured Homes	Class B
Duplexes with Individual Water Meters, per unit	Class B
Apartments, per unit	Class B

New users to the system, other than houses and apartments, shall be billed based on actual water usage. Allowances for high summer water usage may be taken into account by the Finance Director for the City of Stayton.

Accounts in which there is no correlation between water usage and sewerage discharge, as determined above, will be individually calculated by the Finance Director for the City of Stayton.
