RESOLUTION NO. 826

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RATES FOR SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT IN THE CITY OF STAYTON.

WHEREAS, Stayton Municipal Code Chapter 4.08.020(1)(b) permits the establishment of rates for the collection of solid waste;

WHEREAS, The Franchisee, United Disposal, Inc., doing business as Allied Waste, has requested an increase to the current rates due to increased operational costs;

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council conducted a Public Hearing on August 18, 2008 to receive public testimony regarding the proposed new rates; and

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council determined that the rate schedules addressed herein are fair, reasonable, and competitive.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that:

Rates for Monthly Solid Waste Management Services, effective October 1, 2008, shall be as detailed in Attachment A and B to this resolution.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.

Fuel Recovery Fee Schedule



What is the Purpose of the Fee?

The fee will help offset the significant increases in the cost of diesel being consumed to operate our fleet. In addition to the waste stream management industry, some other examples of business/industries charging this kind of fee are FedEx, UPS, landscaping, florists and fuel oil companies, to name a few.

Like other transportation companies, higher fuel costs are affecting our cost structure. The purpose of this fee is simply to cover a portion of the significant increase in fuel costs for trucks used to service our customers. Fuel expense is running at a rate of over 50% from last year. The fee is being created to offset this increase in our expenses.

A fee based approach is preferred over the "normal" rate adjustment process due to the volatility and unpredictability of diesel prices. This approach allows for a quicker response to increased costs while also allowing a decrease in price to our customers should fuel prices begin to fall in the coming months.

What is Allied Currently Doing to Mitigate the Affects of Rising Fuel Costs?

Allied Waste constantly reviews equipment usage and monitors truck and driver fuel economy. Continuous rerouting helps us optimize our route efficiency and decrease fuel consumption. Allied Waste leverages it's nationwide volume consumption to secure the lowest possible fuel prices. Meanwhile, fuel prices/quotes are monitored daily to achieve the very best fuel prices and to maintain a fuel inventory that allows for uninterrupted service to our customers.

How Will the Fuel Recovery Fee Work?

The fee will be added to the customer's monthly invoice. The fee will increase at every 25 cent increment in average fuel rate for the most recent fiscal quarter over the baseline rate of \$2.75. A separate fee rate schedule has been established for Commercial, Industrial and Residential customers.

How was the Baseline Rate Established?

The baseline rate was established by taking Allied's Oregon operations average fuel rate for the year 2007. Therefore, the fee only applies to the increase in costs incurred in 2008. All fuel price increases in 2007 that were not recovered would be included in the calculation of "normal" rate adjustments.

Commercial Fee Schedule:

The Commercial Fuel Recovery Fee will be a single line-item charge on each customer's invoice. To service the average commercial customer, Allied's trucks consume 3.1 gallons of fuel per month. Therefore, every 25 cent increase in fuel rate results in \$0.78 of additional cost per customer, per month.

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Industrial Fee Schedule:

The Industrial Fuel Recovery Fee will be charged on a haul by haul basis. To service the average rolloff haul, Allied's trucks consume 4.3 gallons of fuel. Therefore, every 25 cent increase in fuel rate results in \$1.09 of additional cost per haul.

The Residential Fuel Recovery Fee will be a single line-ifem charge on each customer's invoice. To service the average residential customer, Allied's trucks consume 0.36 gellons of fuel per month. Therefore, every 25 cent increase in fuel rate results in \$0.09 of additional cost per customer, per month.
