## RESOLUTION NO. 834

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STAYTON TO APPLY FOR A TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT TO UPDATE THE STAYTON TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department Transportation (ODOT) is accepting applications for the Transportation and Growth Management Grant Program;

WHEREAS, the Stayton Transportation System Plan was adopted by the City Council in April 2004, and recommends it be updated and revised every five years;

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton recognizes that economic conditions have changed since development of the 2004 Transportation System Plan;

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Growth Management grant requires a 11% match (\$8,250) from the City of Stayton;

WHEREAS, a requirement of the grant application process is that the application include an approved resolution from the governing body authorizing the grant application.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Stayton, through its City Administrator, shall apply for a Transportation and Growth Management Grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for a grant of \$75,000 for updating and revising the Stayton Transportation System Plan.

This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption by the Stayton City Council.
