RESOLUTION No. 770

A RESOLUTION ASSIGNING SANITARY SEWER USER CHARGES: NON INDUSTRIAL FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF STAYTON.

WHEREAS, The Stayton City Council for the City of Stayton has adopted Ordinance No. 781, "Repealing SMC Title 13.24.1190";

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 781 (SMC Title 13.24.1190) requires rates to be established for sanitary sewer service;

WHEREAS, the adopted Wastewater Master Plan recommends a 5% sewer rate increase July 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS, such rates are to be set in resolution form.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that:

Sanitary Sewer rates are hereby adopted July 1, 2006 as follows:

SECTION 1. SANITARY SEWER RATES

Users of the sewer system are classified based on estimated loadings to the sewer system and rates are hereby established for each classification:

Class	Loading	\$/Month
A	Up to 4,000 gal/month	\$ 25.90
В	Up to 6,000 gal/month	\$ 34.65
\mathbf{C}	Up to 10,000 gal/month	\$ 64.71
D	Over 10,000 gal/month (cost per thousand)	\$ 6.47
Ε .	Commercial Recreational Vehicle Waste Disposal	\$ 0.25/gal

Water consumption for the months of October through March shall be used to classify users except that the following classes are hereby established:

Single Family Units and Manufactured Homes	Class B
Duplexes with Individual Water Meters, per unit	Class B
Apartments, per unit	Class B

New users to the system, other than houses and apartments, shall be billed based on actual water usage. Allowances for high summer water usage may be taken into account by the Finance Director for the City of Stayton.

Accounts in which there is no correlation between water usage and sewerage discharge, as determined above, will be individually calculated by the Finance Director for the City of Stayton.
