A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE ADOPTED 2006-07 BUDGET

WHEREAS, after the budget process for the 2006-2007 fiscal year was completed, the swimming pool staff identified much needed equipment to make the pool safer;

WHEREAS, donations were received by the City from various sources for the specific purpose of purchasing the identified equipment;

WHEREAS, the current Swimming Pool budget does not include the additional capacity to spend these funds;

WHEREAS, in order to lawfully spend money, a local government must comply with the requirements of Local Budget Law;

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes 294.326(3) allows for expenditures in the year of receipt of grants, gifts, bequests or devises transferred to the local government in trust for a specific purpose may be made after enactment of a resolution or ordinance authorizing the expenditure.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council wishes to accept these specific purpose gifts and grants and apply them for the purposes for which they were granted; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that line items 65.33.46465 (Donations) and 65.86.71200 (Equipment) should be increased by \$5,000.00 for fiscal year 2006-07 in order to accommodate the donations.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.
