
RESOLUTION NO. 678



RESOLUTION CREATING A MEASURE 7 COMPENSATION APPLICATION DEPOSIT SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Stayton has adopted Ordinance No.821, "Establishing A New General Ordinance For Processing Of Claims Under Ballot Measure 7, Passed By The Voters On November 7, 2000, And Declaring An Emergency"; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 821 requires a deposit to be paid anticipating the city's costs for processing Measure 7 Compensation applications; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 821 requires the deposit be made by Measure 7 Compensation applicants at the initiation of the application process; and

WHEREAS, it is the practice of the City of Stayton that fees, charges and/or deposits be set in resolution form; the expense incurred by the city staff is determined by the criteria set by the City Administrator;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Stayton City Council that the City of Stayton hereby adopts the following deposit schedule:

DEPOSIT SCHEDULE: A specific application shall submit a minimum deposit of \$1000.00 of which \$500.00 is non-refundable. Before a final decision on the application is made by the City Council, the actual costs of processing the application must be satisfied. Based on the actual costs of processing an application, the applicant shall be refunded the amount of city costs which are less than the minimum deposit but more than the non-refundable amount, and if the actual costs are more than the minimum deposit, the applicant shall pay the amount of actual costs over the minimum deposit.
