RESOLUTION No. 686

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF STAYTON, OREGON, ADJUSTING CITY OF STAYTON'S WATER SYSTEMS DEVELOPMENT CHARGE (WATER SDC) FOR INFLATION.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Stayton Municipal Code (SMC) 13.12, the City Council's Resolution 624 (1998), calls for the updating of the Water Systems Development Charge, effective on December 31, 1998 and on every January 1 of every succeeding year starting with the year 2000, by the rate of inflation for new construction as reported in the *Engineering News Record* (ENR), published by the McGraw-Hill Companies, as the Construction Cost Index (1967=1) for the period extending from November of the previous year to October of the succeeding year; and,

WHEREAS, the rate of inflation reported in the ENR for the Construction Cost Index, shows inflation increased from 5.7108 in October 1999 to 5.8330 in November of 2000, an increase of 2.14 percent.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION 1: WATER SDC ADJUSTMENT

The City of Stayton's Water Systems Development Charge collected in accordance with SMC 13.12, shall be increased 2.14 percent by this Resolution, with the following schedule:
