#### RESOLUTION No. 687

## A RESOLUTION ADJUSTING THE CITY OF STAYTON'S WASTEWATER SYSTEMS DEVELOPMENT CHARGE (WASTEWATER SDC) FOR INFLATION.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Stayton Municipal Code (SMC) 13.12, Resolution 609 (November 1997), calls for the updating of the Wastewater Systems Development Charge by the rate of inflation for new construction as reported in the *Engineering News Record* (ENR), published by the McGraw-Hill Companies, as the Construction Cost Index (1967=1) for the period extending from November of the previous year to October of the succeeding year; and,

WHEREAS, the rate of inflation reported in the ENR for the Construction Cost Index, shows inflation increased from 5.7108 in October 1999 to 5.8330 in November of 2000, an increase of 2.14 percent.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

### SECTION 1: WASTEWATER SDC ADJUSTMENT

The Wastewater Systems Development Charge collected in accordance with SMC 13.12 shall be increased 2.14 percent by this Resolution, with the following schedule:
