A RESOLUTION TO PROTECT OREGON JOBS AND ENSURE THE LONG TERM HEALTH AND PRODUCTIVITY OF OREGON'S AGRICULTURE.

WHEREAS, agriculture is the State of Oregon's second largest industry, producing well over \$2 billion worth of products annually; and

WHEREAS, we recognize that the agriculture industry is the largest employer in the City of Stayton and Marion County is the most productive agricultural county in the State; and,

WHEREAS, we appreciate the agricultural industry's presence and valued contributions to our community's economic health and vitality; and


