

RESOLUTION NO. 472

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING A PUBLIC CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A COMMUNOTOR FOR THE STAYTON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, one of the two communutors required to render solids at the Stayton Wastewater Treatment Plant has failed and cannot be repaired; and

WHEREAS, immediate replacement of the unit is necessary for the safe and efficient processing of sewage; and

WHEREAS, Stayton Municipal Code Section 3.04.040 provides that a contract may be exempt from competitive bidding if the Council, by unanimous vote, determines that emergency conditions require prompt execution of the contract; NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED AND DECLARED that one of the two communutors, required to render solid waste at the Stayton Wastewater Treatment Plant, has failed and cannot be repaired; that an immediate replacement of the unit is necessary for the safe and efficient processing of sewage at said Plant; and that the Council, by unanimous vote, determined that an emergency condition exists and said condition requires prompt execution of a contract to allow the replacement of the failed communutor;

IT IS FURTHER ADJUDGED AND DECLARED that the contract to be executed to replace the communutor is hereby exempt from all competitive bidding requirements in order to serve the public health, safety, welfare, convenience, and environmental amenities of the City of Stayton and the inhabitants thereof.
