## RESOLUTION No. 332

RESOLUTION CALLING FOR AN ELECTION DATE TO BE SET FOR THE PROPOSED FIRE DISTRICT ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, located in Marion County, desires Annexation into the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District organized and operating under Chapter 478 of Oregon Revised Statutes as a municipal corporation and special district of the State of Oregon and located within Marion County.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton acknowledges the receipt of the certified Resolution received from the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District adopted on August 6, 1984 and appended hereto and marked Exhibit "B" which is hereby made a part of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton qualifies to be annexed to the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District in that the City is surrounded or substantially enclosed by the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District.

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton has proposed annexation to the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Stayon:

- Section 1. That the Resolution passed by the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District Board and approved by the President of the Board on August 6, 1984 be and hereby is, approved and adopted.
- Section 2. That the City of Stayton hereby calls an election in the City on the date specified in the Resolution of the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District which is the 6th day of November, 1984 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., Pacific Time, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City the question of whether all of the territory located within the Corporate Limits of the City of Stayton, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, and located within Marion County, shall be annexed to the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Be it further resolved that the Marion County Elections Clerk publish notice of such election in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.
- Section 4. Be it further resolved that the appropriate notice of election and ballot title be provided the Marion County Election Clerk.
