

RESOLUTION NO. 212

WHEREAS, pursuant to a condition of the public grant for the Stayton Sewer System dated August 30, 1972 the City of Stayton was to enter into a program determining the extent of sewer system infiltration and to initiate a systematic program for repair and replacement hereto, and

WHEREAS, the City thereupon adopted such a program and pursuant thereto, upon the City's Engineers report the Council by motion adopted, authorized the City Employees "to proceed in whatever manner necessary to get the cities system repaired", and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such motion bids for T.V. inspection were let to Penetryn Systems Inc. on or about February 17, 1975 for inspection and repair to all the cities leaky manholes and a major portion of the Cities Collection System resulting in all leaky manholes being repaired and a significant reduction in collection system infiltration under the \$16,091.95 contract


NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF STAYTON RESOLVES

That the program adopted heretofore by motion of the City Council to determine and initiate whatever necessary to get the cities system repaired be continued, and that as funds become available the repair and replacement of defective sewer lines, as revealed by the said inspection report and recommended by the Cities Engineers, be performed

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order for the City Council be kept advised of the continuing progress of such program the City Recorder shall prepare and present to the Council a report thereof each six months hereafter until further order of the Council
