WHEREAS, it appears that there has been filed with the City of Stayton pursuant to ORS 222.170, a petition representing more than 1/2 of the landowners of a certain territory contiguous to the City of Stayton described in Section 1 hereof, said territory being in the vicinity of Wilco Road, which said petitioners also own more than 1/2 of said land in the contiguous territory and of real property therein representing more than 1/2 of the assessed value of all of said property, which said petitioners desire inclusion of such territory within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, NOW, THEREFORE

> BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON

Section 1. That pursuant to Chapter 199, Oregon Revised Statutes, the Common Council hereby initiates proceedings for the annexation to the City of Stayton, Oregon of the territory lying contiguous to the present city limits and more particularly described as follows: SEE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A"

That the recorder hereby is directed to file with the local Government Boundary Commission for Marion and Polk Counties a certified copy of this resolution together with a map of said area and any other date or copies which the Boundary Commission may request for their study and deliberation.

thence North 80° 35' East 2095.60 feet to an iron bar at the Northwest corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to Grace Neibert by deed recorded in Volume 470, Page 527, Marion County Deed Records;

thence North 89° 51′ 30″ East, along the North line of said Weibert tract, 879.70 feet to an iron pipe which is 880.00 feet North 89° 45′ 30″ West from the center of said Section 9;

thence South 10.00 feet to the Southwest curner of that certain tract of land conveyed to Stayton Canning Co. by deed recorded in Volume 589, Page 455, Marion County Deed Records;

thence South 87° 19' East, along the South line of said Stayton Canning Co. tract, 150.59 feet to an iron rod;

thence South 83° 32' East, along the South line of that certain tract of land conveyed to Stayton Canning Co. by deed recroded in Volume 597, Page 218, Marion County Deed Records, a distance of 108.12 feet to an iron rod;

thence South 88° 06° 30° East, continuing along said South line, 514.35 feet to an iron rod;
