

RESOLUTION NO. 234

WHEREAS, it appears that there has been filed with the City of Stayton pursuant to ORS 222.170 a petition representing more than 1/2 of the landowners of a certain territory contiguous to the City of Stayton described in Section 1 hereof, said territory being in the vicinity of Santiam Street, which said petitioners also own more than 1/2 of said land in the contiguous territory and of real property therein representing more than 1/2 of the assessed value of all of said property, which said petitioners desire inclusion of such territory within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton,

NOW, THEREFORE


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON

Section 1. That pursuant to Chapter 199, Oregon Revised Statutes, the Common Council hereby initiates proceedings for the annexation to the City of Stayton, Oregon of the territory lying contiguous to the present city limits and more particularly described as follows: SEE ATTACHED EXHIBIT "A"

Section 2. That the recorder hereby is directed to file with the local Government Boundary Commission for Marion and Polk Counties a certified copy of this resolution together with a map of said area and any other data or copies which the Boundary Commission may request for their study and deliberation.

A N N E X A T I O N P E T I T I O N A N D C O N S E N T

TO: THE HONORABLE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL
 OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON.

Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned, legal owners of a certain parcel of land lying within and being a part of the following described territory contiguous to the City of Stayton, Oregon, the boundaries of which territory are particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of the County road one-half mile East of the quarter corner between Sections 10 and 11, Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon; thence South 175.00 feet along the East line of a tract of land conveyed to Martin T. Gehlen and wife by deed recorded in Volume 350, Page 017, Deed Records for said County; thence West 165.00 feet to the Southeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to Herman Breitenstein and wife by deed recorded in Volume 573, Page 323, said Deed Records; thence North 175.00 feet to the center of said road; thence East 165.00 feet to the place of beginning.

desire that the above described territory be annexed to and be included within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, Oregon, a municipal corporation, and we do hereby consent to such annexation, without the necessity of any election being called within the area above described, and we do hereby consent that the Common Council of the City of Stayton, Oregon, take steps as are necessary to determine whether or not the said above described area shall be annexed.

This request and consent shall be considered to remain in full force and effect only until one year from date of this petition, at which time the same shall be considered to have been withdrawn, unless on or before said date you shall institute proceedings for said annexation, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 222.111 to 222.190. In such event, this shall be considered to constitute the consent to annexation referred to in ORS 222.170.
