RESOLUTION NO. 240

ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS ALONG EVERGREEN STREET FROM IDA STREET NORTH TO WASHINGTON STREET.

WHEREAS the Common Council of the City of Stayton has held public meetings to discuss the improvement of Evergreen Street from Ida Street north to Washington Street and;

WHEREAS, the construction of sidewalks was not intended to be included in the construction project and;

WHEREAS, it was the suggestion of persons in attendance at those public meetings that sidewalks be constructed during the improvement project,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON OREGON:

The Common Council, pursuant to Ordinance Number 300, hereby declares it necessary and expedient that Evergreen Avenue from Ida Street north to Washington Street, be improved by the inclusion of construction of four foot sidewalks along both sides of said Avenue.

The sidewalks ordered constructed by this Resolution shall be built of Portland Concrete Cement and constructed to the standards provided for in Ordinance Number 446 of the City of Stayton and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such sidewalks shall be completed within 120 days after the adoption and passage of this Resolution.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the sidewalks as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such sidewalks and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
