WHEREAS, Stayton Industrial Properties, the owner of Stayton Industrial Park, has, by and through its contractor, engineer and other agents, constructed certain water, sewer, street, storm sewer, and appurtenant structures in Phase I of said Park according to the City's Standard Specifications, and

Sewer: 210 feet of 6 -inch force main in Deschutes Dr . 430 feet of 10 -inch main in Deschutes Dr . 160 feet of 6 -inch main in Willamette Ave. 440 feet of 8-inch main between Willamette \& Wilco Rd. 70 feet of 6 -inch main from Lot 7 and 265 feet of 8 -inch main to Washington St. 375 feet of 8 -inch main in Washington St.

Storm Sewer: 435 feet of 8 -inch main and 2 catch basins in Deschutes Dr. 230 feet of 10 -inch main and 2 catch basins in Willamette Dr . between Lots 1 and 2
30 feet of 8 -inch main and 2 catch basins at the South end of Willamette Ave.

Street: Deschutes Drive, 685 feet West of Wilco Rd. centerline Willamette Ave., 789.67 feet South and Southwest of Deschutes Dr. centerline
Associated curbs, asphalt, and base
