## RESOLUTION NUMBER 141

Ordering the construction of a 5 foot curb sidewalk on the north side of west Washington Street which abutts on the south side of the Jerry Horrocks property in the City of Stayton, Oregon

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that a 5 foot curb sidewalk be constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, Oregon, upon and along the north side of West Washington Street, which is more specifically described as that tract of land described on volume 557 page 669 deed records from Marion County, Oregon, generally known as 1097 West Washington Street, Stayton, Oregon.

The 5 foot curb sidewalk ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland Cement Concrete as provided by Ordinance Number 300, and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such 5 foot curb sidewalk shall be completed within 60 days from the date of mailing of notice by the City Recorder to the owner of said property of the adoption of this resolution. The Recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct the said 5 foot curb sidewalk as herein ordered and shall include specifications for such 5 foot curb sidewalk and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the City Engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such 5 foot curb sidewalk, the owner of said premises or his agent, shall notify the City Engineer for staking of grades and location.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the 5 foot curb sidewalk as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such 5 foot curb sidewalk and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved, with interest rate of 7% until such lien is paid in full.
