RESOLUTION NUMBER 142

Ordering the construction of curbs on the East side of Third Avenue between Ida Street and Florence Street in the City of Stayton, Oregon.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that new curbs be constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, Oregon, upon and along the east side of Third Avenue between Ida Street and Florence Street in the City of Stayton, Oregon, adjacent to and abutting upon all pieces or parcels of real property known as Santiam Electric Co. 274 N. Third Avenue and Dr. R. P. Anderson office, 264 N. Third Avenue, Stayton, Oregon.

The curbs ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland Cement Concrete as provided by Ordinance Number 300, and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such curbs shall be completed within 60 days from the date of mailing of notice by the City Recorder to the owner of said property of the adoption of this resolution. The recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct the said curb as herein ordered and shall include specifications for such curbs; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the City Engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such curb, the owner of said premises or his agent, shall notify the City Engineer for staking of grades and location.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the curb as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such curb and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved, with interest rate of 7% until such lien is paid in full.
