

RESOLUTION NUMBER 157

ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF CURB AND A FOUR FOOT
SIDEWALK ON BOTH SIDES OF NORTH SECOND AVENUE
BETWEEN VIRGINIA STREET AND THE SALEM DITCH

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council, pursuant to Chapter IX of the City Charter, hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that a curb and four foot sidewalk be constructed where none presently exist, and be replaced where existing curbs and sidewalks are dangerous or not up to standard, along both sides of North Second Avenue between Virginia Street and the Salem Ditch.

The four foot sidewalk and curb ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland Cement Concrete as provided by Ordinance Number 300, and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such curb and sidewalk shall be completed within one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of mailing of notice by the City Recorder to the owner of said property of the adoption of this resolution. The Recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct the said curb and sidewalk as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the City Engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such improvement, the owner of said premises or his agent, shall obtain plans and specifications from the City Engineer, which shall prescribe the kind of curb and sidewalk to be constructed, the material to be used, and the specifications therefore.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the curb and four foot sidewalk as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such improvement and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
