## RESOLUTION NO. 184

A RESOLUTION ORDERING THE PAVING OF PARKING STRIPS ALONG A PORTION OF NORTH SECOND AVENUE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The common council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that the parking area located between the center paving and the curb line of North Second Avenue between Marion Street and Washington Street be improved by bringing such area to proper grade and subsurface, and by paving such area with asphaltic concrete.

The preparation and paving ordered constructed by this resolution shall be constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved, except that the City shall bear all administrative, legal and engineering expenses, and will pay all preparation and paving costs in excess of \$1.90 per front foot on each side of said avenue. Said improvement shall be constructed according to the plans and specifications of the city engineer.

The city recorder shall post at least five notices inviting bids for the making of said improvement as provided by the Charter of the City of Stayton and may provide a date and time at a council meeting for the opening of such bids. Such notice shall specify the improvement to be made, shall provide that each bid submitted must be accompanied by a certified check equal to ten percent (10%) of the amount of the bid, and shall specify the date of posting.
