## RESOLUTION NO. 189

WHEREAS, various councilmen have business interests in and about the City, and

WHEREAS, these interests may affect their considerations of various questions and matters submitted to the council for consideration, and

WHEREAS, the councils of other cities have been criticized for not disclosing their business interests; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

That on or before the 1st day of February of each and every year, or upon taking the oath of office, each councilman, planning commission member, employee, including all regular salaried employees and also attorneys and engineers, shall file with the city Recorder a written statement under oath of his employer, employment and property ownership by address or description within the city limits, interests in partnerships or corporations that own property within the city limits and a list of those properties by address or description, the addresses or descriptions of all property interests held in the name of a partner, and such other information that would disclose any personal interest based on his business affiliations that would, might or could be construed as affecting his judgments as a member of the council or in the exercise of his functions whatever they be on behalf of the City of Stayton.
