It is hereby resolved by the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, that it being necessary for the benefit of the property owners of the Town of Stayton and the general public that

Certain premises, to-wit: that certain strip of land 40 feet in width, being 20 feet on each side of the following described center line:

Beginning at a point 1000.25 feet East and 757.05 feet South from the quarter corner between Sections 10 and 15 in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon; thence South 84° 30' West 179.30 feet; thence South 71° 39' West 218.90 feet; thence North 57° 11' West 254.80 feet, thence North 68° 15' West 154.30 feet; thence South 49° 12' West 168.70 feet; thence South 88° 15' West 88.10 feet to the Easterly line of a County Road; Thence North 6° 00' West along the Easterly line of said County Road 142.00 feet; thence West 30.00 feet to the center of said County Road.
