RESOLUTION #53

On motion duly moved and seconded the following preambles and resolution were unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 487 gives protection to existing utilities in that they may contract for a division of service territory, that it will tend to alleviate the wasteful duplication of facilities which creates a cluttered unsightly community;

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 487 does not ban the start of a municipal system;

WHEREAS, Government controlled monopolies are well regulated and under direct scrutiny of state regulatory agencies.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Stayton City Council, Stayton, Oregon, supports and recommends the passage of Senate Bill No. 487.
