RESOLUTION NO. 68

BE IT RESOLVED this 5th day of April, 1965, by the Common Council of the City of Stayton sitting in regular session that, whereas the following described property was recently annexed to the City of Stayton, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which is 40.38 chains North 89° 11' East and 45.3 links South 0° 39' East from the quarter section corner between Sections 10 and 11, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon, said point being in the middle of the County Road leading from Stayton to Mehama, Oregon; thence South 89° 23' East along the middle of the County Road 3.163 chains; thence South 0° 39' East 3.163 chains; thence North 89° 23' West 3.163 chains to a point on the West line of that certain tract of land described in Deed recorded on page 564, Book 284, Deed Records of Marion County, Oregon; thence North 0° 39' West 3.163 chains to the place of beginning; being situated in Section 11, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, State of Oregon. Excluding any and all county roads.

WHEREAS, prior to annexation to the City of Stayton the said above described property was subject to and was part of the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Stayton elects to cause the withdrawal of the said annexed property from the Stayton Rural Fire Protection District, to become incorporated within said city to be subject to its laws, ordinances and government appertaining thereto; now, therefore,

The City shall hold a public hearing to hear objections to the withdrawal of the said property from the Stayton Rural Fire

Protection District and the City Recorder shall give notice of the said hearing to be published and posted in accordance with the law pertaining thereto.
