RESOLUTION NUMBER 91

Ordering paving of east side of 3d Street between Virginia Street and Washington Street.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that Third Street between Virginia Street and Washington Street be improved by paving with asphaltic concrete to a width of 10 feet from the curb line to the edge of the existing pavement.

The total cost of said improvement shall be levied upon the property especially benefitted thereby, as provided by the Charter of the City of Stayton. Such paving shall be completed within 30 days from the date of mailing of notice by the city recorder to the owner of said property of the adoption of this resolution. The recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to improve the street as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the city engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before improving such street, the owner shall consult the city engineer as to the type of asphalt and material to be used and the specifications therefore.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the street improvement as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such street improvement and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
