

RESOLUTION NUMBER 95

Ordering construction of curbs and 5 foot curb sidewalks on the north side of West Washington Street between First Avenue and the centerline of Evergreen Avenue.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that a new curb and a 5 foot curb sidewalk be constructed within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, Oregon, upon and along the north side of West Washington Street between First Avenue and to the centerline of Evergreen Avenue, adjacent to and abutting upon all pieces or parcels of real property located between First Avenue and to the centerline of Evergreen Avenue on Washington Street.

The curb and 5 foot curb sidewalk ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland Cement Concrete as provided by Ordinance Number 300, and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. Such curb and 5 foot curb sidewalk shall be completed within 120 days after the engineering data is available. The recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct the said curb and 5 foot curb sidewalk as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the city engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such curb and 5 foot curb sidewalk, the owner of said premises or his agent, shall obtain plans and specifications from the city engineer, which shall prescribe the kind of curb and 5 foot curb sidewalk to be constructed, the material to be used, and the specifications therefore.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the curb and 5 foot curb sidewalk as hereby ordered, and within the time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to bring about the construction of such curb and 5 foot curb sidewalk and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
